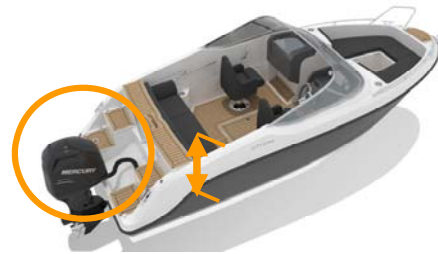

UNCOMPROMISED SECURITY ON BOARD

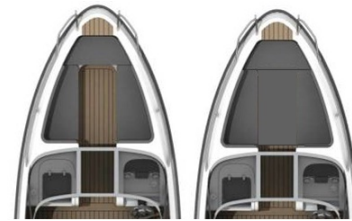
- Good cockpit depth for a secure feeling on board, even with young passengers thanks to the high freeboards

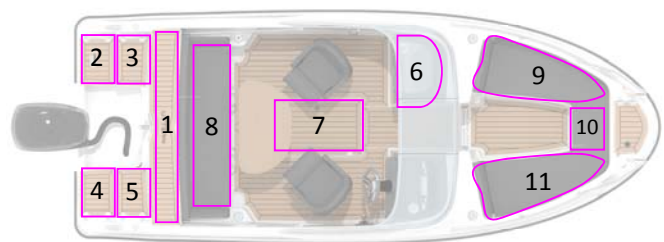
LARGEST BOW SEATING IN ITS CATEGORY AND LOUNGE CONVERSION

INTELLIGENT STORAGE SOLUTIONS

- **1.-** The fully enclosed canvas packs neatly away underneath the top step at the rear of the boat thanks to its integrated canvas storage system which also provides dedicated storage space for the navigation lights
- **2.3.4.5.-** A total of 4 storage compartments underneath the steps over the transom area to store the anchor, mooring equipment such as fender and ropes. The swim ladder is also integrated underneath the steps
- **6.-** For all those small items such as sunglasses, documents and keys, there is a convenient glove box on the helm station
- **7.-** Integrated storage for the optional 12v cool box and cockpit table below the deck
- **8.-** Underneath the rear seats you will find a dedicated storage for the ski mast and ample of space to store away water ski equipment and accessories
- **9.10.11.-** A wealth of storage underneath each of the 3 bow seats
